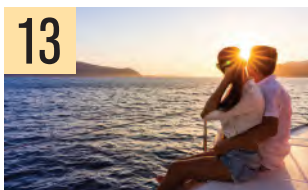

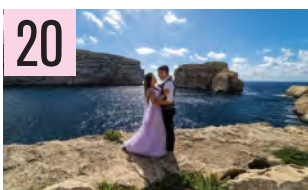

THE TWO TRAVEL MINDSETS

Cost certainty and high-value bucket list bookings are the dual dynamic for the upcoming summer season, according to the Advantage Travel Partnership's latest trends report.

AHEAD OF the highly-anticipated summer season, the Advantage Travel Partnership has released new insights into booking behaviour, and the data is showing two distinct approaches to holiday planning: high demand for cost certainty, and a commitment to high-value once-in-a-lifetime experiences.

Travellers this summer are navigating geopolitical uncertainties, and as a result are choosing holidays that offer either total financial security, or personal meaning. Families are prioritising budget-friendly all-inclusive packages, while couples and premium travellers are investing in long-haul exploration and cruising.

All-inclusive remains the dominant choice for holidaymakers this summer, accounting for 38% of all bookings. Spain and Türkiye are seeing the biggest uptick, particularly among families. This demand for cost certainty has been further validated by recent fuel surcharge pledges from major tour operators.

Despite the global economic pressures, the appetite for premium long-haul remains high, with destinations such as the US, Canada, and regions in the Far East seeing average booking values increase by 7% compared to last year.

Cruise continues to grow across the industry, with the sector now representing 15% of total booked revenue. That growth is being driven by three key areas: convenience of no-fly cruises from the UK; the large volume of Mediterranean itineraries; and the desire for long-haul travel that is experienced but also hassle-free.

CEO Julia Lo Bue-Said OBE, said, "We are seeing a market that refuses to compromise on the annual holiday, but it is becoming far more strategic in how they secure it [...] We're seeing a sophisticated evolution of travel where value, flexibility, peace of mind and a seamless journey are the new currency and the benefit of booking through an expert travel agent has never proved to be more valuable."

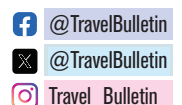


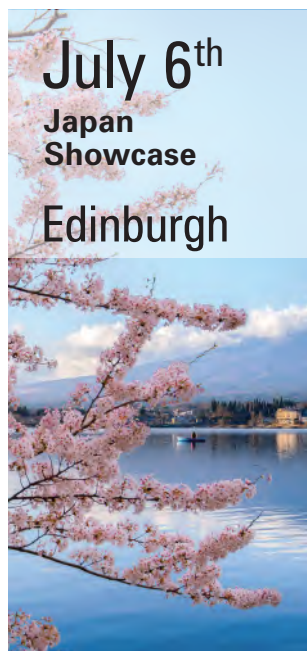

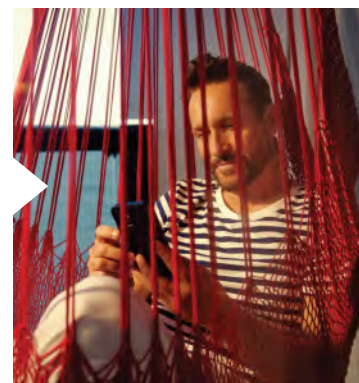

Travel reaches new heights

MORE THAN 61 million passengers travelled through UK airports in the first three months of the year, breaking previous records for travel between January and March.

The data, released by the UK Civil Aviation Authority, shows holidaymakers heading off towards sunnier European destinations, with the number of passengers travelling to Madrid and Las Palmas increasing by 14% and 11% respectively. This period includes the initial

time after the conflict in the Middle East began, impacting passengers in some regions.

The airports that recorded the largest proportional growth in passengers include London Southend (247%), Cardiff (24%), Bournemouth (14%), and Newcastle (9%).

The most popular destinations in the first three months of 2026 for British holidaymakers were Dublin, Amsterdam, Geneva, Tenerife and Dubai.

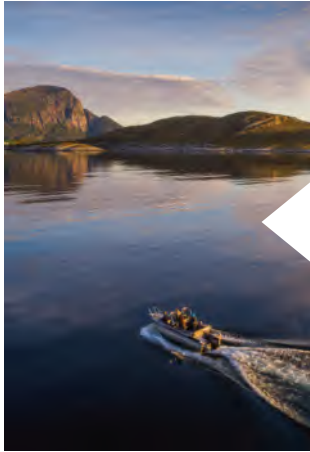

WHEN YOU think of cruising, what comes to mind first? For many clients a cruise still conjures up images of big ships, vast oceans, lots of days at sea and big production shows. Yet there is another side to cruising that lends itself perfectly to today's demand for slower, more experiential travel – river cruising.

We already know that cruisers love to cruise and that once they are converted, repeat business is high. They love the fact that there are multiple destinations in one trip, the convenience of unpacking once and the great value for money cruises can offer. River cruising builds on this with smaller ships, an even more relaxed atmosphere and the chance to step off your ship right in the heart of your destination, whether that is a grand capital city or a small character-filled town.

Across Europe, each river has its own personality and its own type of client. The Danube is ideal for those who would like to explore grand imperial capitals, while the Rhine appeals to anyone who loves castles, vineyards and storybook villages. Art and history lovers enjoy the Seine and the Douro offers more intimate, wine focused cruises through Portugal's dramatic river valleys. Beyond Europe, long haul rivers such as the Nile, Mekong, Yangtze, Magdalena and Amazon add a genuine sense of adventure and "time travel" as ships sail past temples, fortresses and riverbank communities that feel as if they have not changed in centuries.

Through my own work as a co-founder of The River Experience, I have seen how powerful river cruises can be in opening cruising up to a wider mix of customers. Themed itineraries give clients the chance to choose a river journey that reflects their own interests and travel style.
