

### LATA Expo 2021 to go ahead virtually in October

THE LATIN American Travel Association's (LATA) flagship event, LATA Expo, will now be going ahead as a live event in October 2021.

### Thailand to reopen to international travellers from July 1

FROM JULY 1 2021, the popular tourist island of Phuket will be the first destination in Thailand to welcome international travellers, and from October, five further tourist areas will ease restrictions.

With this, Thailand will begin to remove quarantine requirements and open its borders to fully vaccinated travellers from this summer.

From October, Phuket, Krabi, Phangnga, Koh Samui, Chonburi (Pattaya) and Chiang Mai will all be accessible, quarantine free, for

vaccinated travellers. Travellers are required to stay for at least seven days at the point of entry so should plan their itinerary accordingly i.e. seven days in one of the named destinations above before exploring elsewhere in Thailand.

Chiravadee Khunsub, director of Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) London, said, "From October, five further popular destinations will reopen ahead of our peak season, ready to welcome winter sun travellers..."







## In the hot seat with... Graça Silva



Graça Silva, SATA Azores, sat down with Travel Bulletin to talk about the airlines' new route to Stansted, the importance of UK holidaymakers, and how integral the travel trade is to the company's future plans...

#### Tell us about SATA Azores' new route to Stansted...

As part of our Business Plan 2021-25 for the IATA Summer 2021 season, SATA Azores Airlines plans to add three new routes, including London (STN - Stansted) to Ponta Delgada (PDL - Azores / Portugal).

In June 2021, the airline expects to restart flights to and from London with three weekly flights (on Thursdays, Fridays, and Sundays), departing PDL at 7:20 am and arriving at STN at 12:05 pm. The return flight departs STN at 1:05 pm, arriving at PDL at 4:05 pm local time.

The air operation will begin in June until the end of September 2021 and will resume in 2022. The company also plans to increase the operating frequency and validity in the coming years, aiming to achieve, by the end of 2025, a daily offer throughout the entire period.

### What kind of UK holidaymaker do the new routes appeal to?

Nature and leisure lovers are the most appropriate visitors for the routes we intend to

launch. The direct connection between Stansted and Ponta Delgada allows several possibilities. such as the Azores Stopover programme. On the other hand, we also connect to Madeira, making it possible to discover the two Portuguese archipelagos in one trip.

#### How is the airline adapting to this new era of travel?

2021 will not be a year for expansion or growth. Still, the airline continues to improve its services, precisely to adapt to this new era of travel. The airline incorporated, over a year ago, new operational procedures due to the pandemic.

Between 2020 and 2021, we made several organisational changes that allow us to be agile and present a more competitive service to our customers.

During the forced aviation pause, we took the opportunity to improve processes and keep investing in our staff's training. We took advantage of all the business opportunities that arose. such as charter air operations and air cargo. These opportunities allowed us to reestablish our relationships with the leading national and international tour operators. In operational and commercial terms, we consider that we are in a better position today than we were in 2019.

Given this, and for the moment, our greatest desire is to show those who choose to fly with us the quality and reliability of the service we provide and the beauty and surprising quietness of the destinations to which we fly.

### How are you looking to engage with the UK travel trade?

We can say that including the trade in our marketing plan is essential, and we intend to keep up the outreach by organising monthly webinars, staying in touch using newsletters and workshops, and participating in a trade show as soon as possible.

Of course, we would like to invite trade partners to come and see the fantastic place for themselves on a FAM trip.

The trade is essential for an airline, as they are the best partners to promote the destination and introduce it to their customers. With the best partnership through our GSA in the market, the trade will be well-informed about SATA Azores Airlines and its destinations.


