IN IT FOR THE LONG HAUL

It is out with short-haul and in for the long as booking data has revealed that holidays further afield are making up the top 10 wish list destinations for 2024.

BID GOODBYE to those summers spent in the Costa Del Sol and Fuerteventura and instead set your sights further afield as research conducted by Your Co-op Travel has found that long haul destinations now sit firmly at the top of traveller wish-lists.

Booking data for 2024 has found the average length of stay will be nine days, indicating that the post-pandemic holiday boom is continuing into the new year.

Barbados and the Maldives both feature in the top 10 most booked destinations for the first time in recent years, knocking shorthaul favourites out of the ranks.

Four new destinations enter the top 10 list for 2024, including USA multi-centre trips covering Las Vegas and New York,
Dubrovnik and the Algarve.

The demand for cruises has also risen dramatically, with bookings up 56% in 2023 year-on-year. Short-haul cruises have been revealed as the third-most booked holiday type for this year, overtaking short-haul city

breaks for the first time since before 2022 as travellers are eager to embark on a different type of journey and discover something new.

NEWS

Last year, the Norwegian Fjords topped the cruising charts, with a 46% year on year increase in bookings. Based on current booking figures, it looks to be in the running to do it again this year, with Norway, the Caribbean and the Canary Islands rounding out the top three.

Natalie Quiney, content and ecommerce manager at Co-op Holidays, commented on the figures, saying that "It is unsurprising to see cruises sailing up holidaymakers' wishlist, as with a host of on board amenities and the ease of discovering bucket list locations like the Norwegian Fjords or Caribbean Islands being accessible by sea, hopping on board a ship can be a great way to travel whether with friends or cross-generational groups."

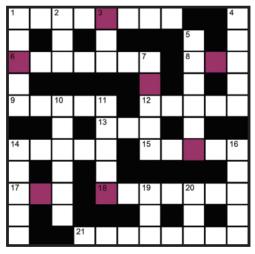

INDUSTRY, insight by...



Andy Harmer, CLIA's managing director for the UK & Ireland, sets course for 2024, spotlighting the destination-intensive nature of cruising as a key selling point.

THE WEALTH of destinations on offer to passengers has always been central to the advantages of taking a cruise. Travellers only need to unpack once when taking a holiday at sea, and can then take advantage of landmark locations and hidden gems across the likes of the Mediterranean, northern Europe, the Caribbean and Asia.

As cruise ships are back to sailing on a global basis, we are once again highlighting how the world is within easy reach via our member lines. More specifically, we have over 20 vessels entering the market this year, with four million additional passengers required to meet capacity.
